

Payment of taxes in the event of a Postal Strike:

The Canadian Union of Postal Workers (CUPW) has issued a strike notice, which means that they will be in a legal position to strike as early as Monday October 22, 2018. It is not clear whether a strike would be full or rotating or if it may be averted. Should rotating strike action occur, the postal service will continue to operate.

The final installment due date for 2018 taxes is **October 31, 2018**.

The Township of Puslinch will NOT be responsible for Canada Post delays. There are a number of options for paying your tax bills:

Pre-Authorize Tax Payment Plan – Monthly or installment options

Internet/Telephone Banking – Set the Township up as a bill payment – check with your bank for payment processing times.

Interac/Cash – At the Township office only

Cheque – In person at our office or through the drop slot at the front door. Payments that are received in the drop box after hours are stamped as of the next business day.
