THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PUSLINCH

BY-LAW NUMBER 25 /04

Being a by-law to designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or portion thereof under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies.

WHEREAS Subsection 7 of Section 122 of *the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter H.8, as amended, provides that:

The municipal corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway may by by-law designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or portion thereof under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies;

AND WHEREAS the reduced load period is deemed necessary for the protection of certain highways in the Corporation of the Township of Puslinch;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Puslinch enacts as follows:

1. The provisions of Subsections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Section 122 of *the Highway Traffic Act* apply to all Township highways and roads within the corporate limits and under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the Township of Puslinch, during the period from the 1st day of January to the 31st day of December, inclusive in each and every year.
2. This by-law shall not become effective until appropriate signs have been erected and are on display.
3. By-law Number 14/89 is hereby repealed.
